Re: Case 17-T-0752 - Application of PSEG Long Island LLC on Behalf of and as Agent for the Long Island Lighting Company d/b/a LIPA for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need Pursuant to Article VII of the Public Service Law for the Western Nassau Transmission Project

Dear Secretary Burgess:

On August 23, 2019, PSEG Long Island LLC on Behalf of and as Agent for the Long Island Lighting Company d/b/a LIPA, a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Long Island Power Authority ("PSEG Long Island") filed an Environmental Management and Construction Plan ("EM&CP") with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") in the above-captioned proceeding.

Since the time of this filing, PSEG Long Island has received comments from Department of Public Service Staff. As part of PSEG Long Island's responses to this party, it has revised certain portions of the EM&CP. Accordingly, PSEG Long Island encloses for filing with the Commission in the above-referenced matter the following revised and additional portions of the EM&CP on file:

- A full replacement of the EM&CP Table of Contents;
- A full replacement of the EM&CP Narrative;
- For Appendix A, a full replacement of the Plan and Profile Drawings associated with the Underground Cable and Trenchless Crossings;
- A full replacement for Appendix B – MPT Drawings;
- For Appendix C – SWPPP, a new Appendix G containing signed MS4 acceptance forms; and
- A new appendix (Appendix J – Waste Disposal Matrix), which includes waste stream, handling and storage methods, waste receiving facility, facility waste program and permit number, and transport information.

Additionally, in recognition that copies of the entire August 23, 2019 filing were served on and delivered to other parties and to local libraries for public access on a single CD, PSEG Long Island will promptly deliver to all recipients of the first CD another CD containing the entire filing as now corrected and revised.

PSEG Long Island respectfully requests that the Commission approve the enclosed revised EM&CP as expeditiously as possible, specifically at the Commission session scheduled for November 14, 2019.
